A letter from the new provider, Chartwells has been emailed to families, along with a copy of the menu. Meal prices remain the same at £2.30 per day and children will have the option of choosing between two different main meals or a jacket potato with filling.

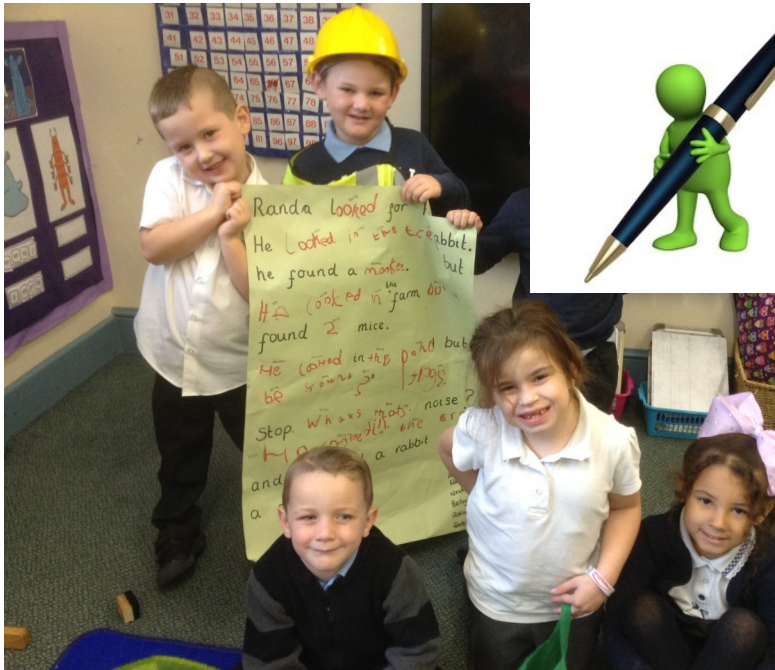
Well done to Joe in Peckover Class for achieving his first grading in Karate.
