You can do this on TT rockstars - if you need any support please let me know.

EG.

$$1 \times 5 = 5$$

$$5 \times 1 = 5$$

$$5 \div 1 = 5$$

$$5 \div 5 = 1$$

Children need to know these multiplication and related division facts by the end of the year for the 2, 3 5 and 10 times table.

<p>Read a story that has a dragon, castle or knights in it. Draw a story map to show the different events in the story. Or review the story for somebody else.</p> 	<p>Can you find out information about George and the Dragon Legend? What happened? Why was George famous?</p> 	<p>Write some maths word problems based on our topic for a friend to solve. EG. Each nest has 6 eggs. The dragon needs to protect 5 nests. How many eggs would that be altogether? $6 \times 5 =$</p>
<p>Can you create your own 3D dragon? Make sure you draw out a plan first and then create your masterpiece. What materials will you use? Can you write instructions for someone else to make it?</p> 	<p>Why do the Welsh have a Dragon on their flag?</p>  <p>Can you find out the reason why they have this and present the information you have uncovered about it.</p>	<p>Can you create your own map of a fantasy land? What might be there? Castles? Trolls? Elves or Fairies? Knights? Forbidden woods? Make sure you put a key on your map so we know what they are.</p> 
<p>You might come up with your own idea about dragons.</p>
