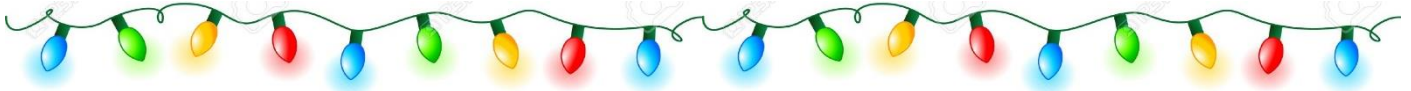

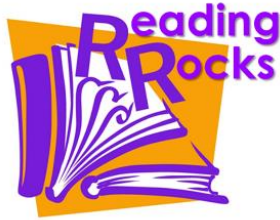


## Family Cafés
